Waterfront Construction

After over 20 years as an empty lot, it looks like the former site of Black-Clawson Kennedy will not be empty much longer. Construction equipment appeared at the site in September and began clearing the trees that had grown over the last two decades to prepare the land for construction work.

According to plans published by the City of Owen Sound, Hansa Financial & Property Management plan to built 6 four-storey apartment buildings plus an amenities building for residents.

Many long-time residents of Owen Sound remember the days of Black-Clawson Kennedy, or even the foundry's earlier life as Wm. Kennedy & Sons. While the new construction will stray from the lot's previous use, we're excited to see the new development move forward!


